Hydrant Relief Valve

In conjunction of the mutual covenants contained herein, it is agreed to between the North Dakota Rural Water Systems Association (NDRWSA) and _____(System), as follows:

NDRWSA makes this service available to member water systems.

NDRWSA will provide the following:

1. Hydrant Relief Valve
2. Delivery of above equipment to member water system
3. Proper equipment operating procedures

The member system will provide the following:

1. Flushing of fire hydrant before hydrant relief valve is connected to hydrant
2. System will provide all necessary employees' insurance coverage and safety equipment for use by water system personnel (not NDRWSA's employees).
3. The system is responsible for the security and safe return of the Electric Valve Operator to NDRWSA when requested by NDRWSA or otherwise in a timely manner.
4. The system agrees not to loan this equipment to any other entity or individual without the authorization of NDRWSA.
5. The system agrees to pay the appropriate fees to NDRWSA for the equipment's use. The fee for the use of the equipment is required to cover NDRWSA's cost of repairing and maintaining equipment for member system usage.

Additional requirements:

- 1) NDRWSA or its employees will not be held liable for any equipment or water system damage, loss of water service, injury to employees or bystanders or claims made by a third party due to the use of the hydrant relief valve.
